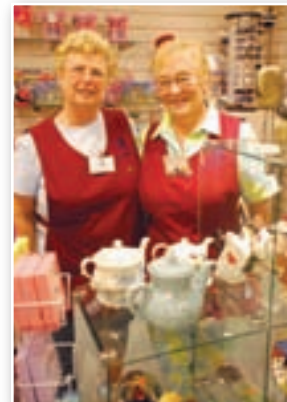

After so many years of planning, we are finally getting close to seeing the Inn on the Pond become a reality.

During a national recession, the biggest hurdle has been securing appropriate financing for this project, which will assure financial stability for the Inn on the Pond and our other senior living activities. The financial world has changed dramatically, and our Finance Committee has had to be innovative, patient and persistent. With the support of some major benefactors, we are getting close to achieving our goal of breaking ground for this beautiful, full service assisted living residence.

Menorah Manor Senior Living purchased the Golda Meir/Kent Jewish Center (GMKJC) Clearwater property in 2008. In November 2009, the GMKJC was demolished, and the site was cleared in preparation for the construction of the Inn on the Pond. Many volunteers serve on various committees and have made important decisions, so that once we complete the financing, we will be able to promptly break ground; construction will take about one year.

The Inn on the Pond will be the only Jewish assisted living residence in northern Pinellas County. In addition to superbly accommodating the needs of our Jewish seniors, it will be a gathering place for the community to hold meetings, eat lunch in the Bistro, visit the butterfly gardens, and more.

We need you to be involved in this exciting development in our Jewish community.

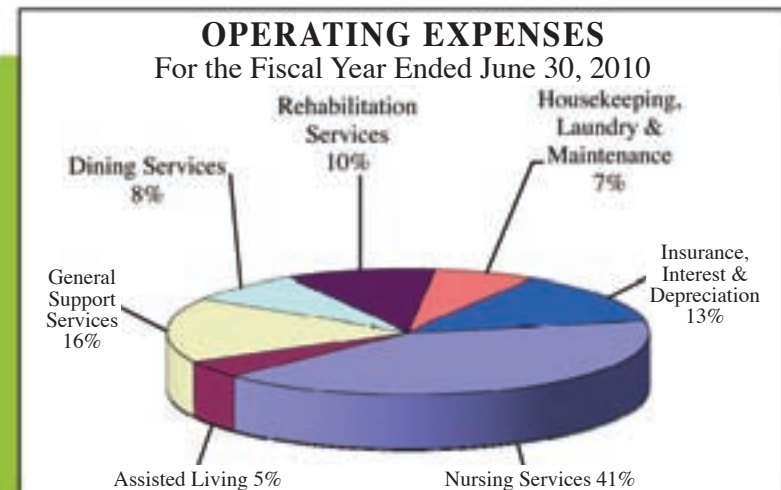
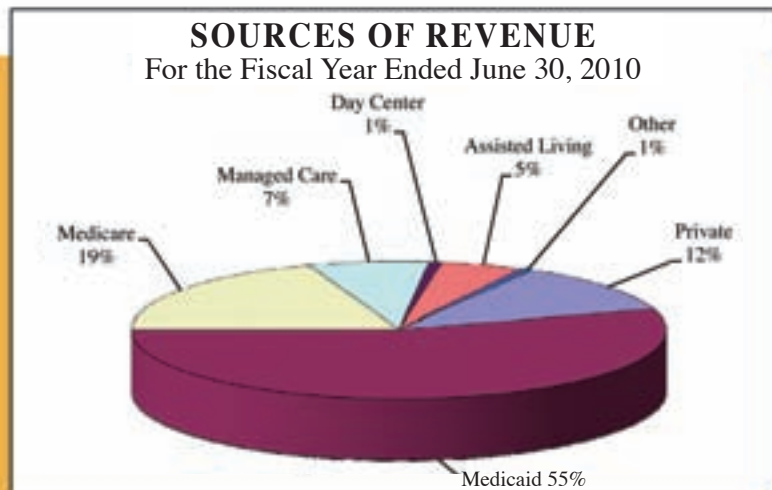

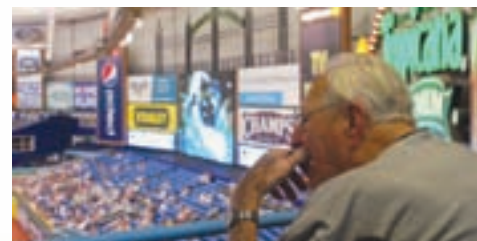
2009-2010 Highlights
